From Dialog to d-AI-log: Three Structures for Collaboration, Coordination, and Cooperation

This workshop offers a simple way to think and work together without running a full project. We practice three structured dialogue patterns: Collaborate (Challenge), Coordinate (Add), and Cooperate (Sequence), starting from a shared SDG-inspired goal: contributing to peace. Hosting the workshop in Poland, a frontline country, makes this topic concrete rather than abstract.

In small groups, we generate role-based questions, map how different professional lenses reshape the same goal, and then translate these patterns into prompt architectures, so that AI tools can challenge, align and sequence our thinking instead of merely reflecting it.

Number of participants: 20 (5 tables x 4) to ensure everyone speaks and each table produces a reusable set of questions and prompts.
