# Center in Motion: Relationships and Choices in Higher Education Teaching

Higher education teaching is not neutral, it is always organized around a certain “center” that shapes our decisions and actions. What (or whom) we prioritize influences not only how classes unfold, but also the quality and character of the relationships that emerge within them.

In this workshop, we will explore different possible “centers” of teaching practice and engage in activities that support their intentional and flexible shaping. We will consider how different orientations - toward process, content, the student, method, or the teacher - transform relationships in the academic environment and open up different possibilities for learning.

This workshop is an invitation to reflect on your own practice and to experiment with a more intentional, relational approach to teaching.
